

All About The Westin Bonaventure

LOCATION

The Westin Bonaventure Hotel and Suites encompasses one whole city block in the heart of the Los Angeles Downtown business district just steps away from major attractions and facilities including: the Los Angeles Convention Center, Staples Center, MOCA, the Music Center, Disney Music Hall, Olvera Street, Little Tokyo, Chinatown, and the Garment District.

Four Sky Bridges provide guests access to adjacent buildings without setting foot onto the street including the World Trade Center, the YMCA fitness facility, the 444 Plaza building and the Union Bank building. The Westin Bonaventure is often referred to as a “city within a city” due to its unsurpassed scope of facilities, services and amenities.

ARCHITECTURE

A masterpiece in contemporary hotel design, The Westin Bonaventure’s five mirrored cylindrical towers soar 35 stories. One of the most dramatic buildings to grace the skyline of the West Coast, this enduring landmark is one of the most photographed and its futuristic architectural design makes The Westin a worldwide symbol representing Los Angeles.

ACCOMMODATIONS

As the largest hotel in Los Angeles, The Westin Bonaventure has 1,354 guest rooms, including 135 suites, all showcasing dramatic city views. Suites are in nine categories ranging from 240 to 2,520 square feet.

A \$35 million interior renovation, including all guest rooms, was completed in 2004.

One of The Westin Bonaventure’s five towers is an exclusive Executive All-Suite Tower comprised of 94 suites. Spacious suites feature a separate bedroom and living room. Amenities include: two televisions; a wet bar, refrigerator, microwave, and coffee/tea maker.

HEALTH/FITNESS & RECREATION

Bonaventure Club: At 9,000-square-feet, The Bonaventure Club is downtown Los Angeles’ largest hotel spa and among the most expansive traditional Asian spas in the country. The \$2 million dollar Bonaventure Club features an Asian-themed approach to spa treatments and services in a club-like ambiance distinguishing itself from European style spas in both style and décor as well as treatments.

Garden Deck & Pool: Surrounded by verdant landscaping, the half-acre outdoor deck frames a 50 x 100 foot heated pool. Poolside dining is available through Room Service.

Running Track: The circular running track is located on the top level of the atrium lobby and features a multi-station weight-training course along the perimeter of the track.

Fitness Center: Equipment ranges from free weights to StairMasters and treadmills. Adjacent to the hotel is the 85,000-square-foot Ketchum Center which offers tennis, racquetball, handball, and squash.

DINING

L.A. Prime: Noted for its impeccable service, the Bonaventure’s signature 35th floor restaurant couples understated glamour with a relaxed dinner ambiance and captivating views. L.A. Prime’s fabulous customized USDA certified cuts of prime beef are flown in from Chicago’s noted Stockyards Packing. Executive Chef Patrick Mullin was previously executive chef at the critically acclaimed Ana Mandara in San Francisco. Prior to that he was executive chef at the Sherwood Hotel in Taipei, perennially ranked one of the top five restaurants in Asia. Serving dinner nightly, L.A. Prime is open 5:00 to 10:30 pm. Sunday through Thursday and 5:00 to 11:00 pm on Friday and Saturday.

Lakeview Bistro: Specialties include seafood and pasta served in a casual European street café ambiance which overlooks the reflecting pools in the six-level atrium lobby. Lakeview Bistro is open daily for breakfast and lunch.

BonaVista Lounge: Spin around the City of Angels at the 34th floor BonaVista Lounge, accessed by the staircase at L.A. Prime. The popular lounge makes a 360-degree revolution hourly. Appetizers are complemented by an array of beverages all presented in much-in-demand novelty glasses to take home as a memoir.

The Lobby Court: Located in the atrium's lobby central, Starbucks coffee, light breakfast fare and fresh Krispy Kreme Doughnuts are served from early dawn until noon, and then cocktail service begins with Happy Hour hors d'oeuvres after 5:00 pm.

International & Eateries: The multi-level atrium lobby features 14 additional dining Options including: The Health Winner, Cap'n Lee's Seafood, Church's Chicken, Panda Hut, Uncle Moustache, Korean BBQ Plus, Mameda Japanese Restaurant, Bonaventure Brewing Company with an on-site microbrewery, Olive Branch, Gourmet Pizzeria, Jyokamachi Japanese Restaurant, Marcelo's, Hot Dogs Plus, Mandarin West and Subway Sandwiches & Salads.

With 24 meeting and function rooms totaling 106,000-square-feet that can be arranged in 44 different configurations, the hotel can accommodate varied events from corporate meetings and private parties to exhibitions and conventions of up to 3,000 attendees. The facilities include the greatest number of small meeting rooms in downtown Los Angeles as well as the city's largest ballroom – the 26,108-square-foot California Ballroom. The half-acre garden deck is also available for outdoor events.
